Auditions will be held Monday, September 23rd & Tuesday, September 24th from 6:30-9:30pm in the lobby of the Liberty Center. Each evening offers two audition sessions, one from 6:30-8pm & one from 8-9:30pm. Those auditioning should attend the session of their choice & plan on staying for the full 90 minutes.

No prepared audition material is necessary. Those auditioning should come ready to learn & sing two selections from the show, "The Letter #1" & "Alone". Auditioners will learn & sing the songs as a group before singing them individually. There will also be cold readings from the script.

The songs can be found on the show's original cast recording, available on YouTube & most music streaming services. Auditioners are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the songs prior to auditions.

Callbacks will be held on Wednesday, September 25th from 6:30-9:30pm in the Liberty Center lobby & will consist of learning a basic dance combination as well as additional vocal work as time allows.

Wear comfortable clothing/shoes & bring a pen/pencil for auditions & callbacks.

The following roles are available for performers age 13 & up (must turn 13 on or before December 8, 2024):

FROG: Caring & loyal, Frog always looks out for his best friend Toad. An optimist who's glass is always half full.

TOAD: A well-meaning worry-wart, Toad is a bit impatient but always a kind & dedicated friend to Frog.

SNAIL: A little creature who's given a big job. A hilarious show-stopping role.

BIRDS: The narrators of the story who guide the audience through the four seasons & enjoy some tasty cookies along the way.

TURTLE/MOUSE/LIZARD: Three pondside critters who have a big laugh at Toad's expense.

FATHER FROG/MOTHER FROG/YOUNG FROG: The main characters in a spooky story told on a dark & stormy night.

SQUIRRELS: Nutty pranksters who love to upset perfectly raked piles of fall leaves.

MOLES: Up from down under, the Moles help Frog & Toad navigate a wild sled ride down a steep & snowy hill.

All roles are gender neutral. Some roles may be doubled depending on audition turnout.

Rehearsals will begin Tuesday, October 1st at the Liberty Center. Performance

dates are December 6-8th.
